Fullards Farm is located 3 miles north of St Ives (A14 junction 26) and 7.5 miles from junction 23 of the A14 at Huntingdon. Woodhurst is accessed from the A141 to the west and the B1040 to the east.

Just after passing the Woodhurst village signs turn off the main through road, into South Street. The farmhouse is located approximately half way along the lane, opposite a white painted field gate with adjacent kissing gate and footpath sign. Please park on the gravel driveway at the left hand side of the house.
